Food Booths:

\$500 booth, includes 10'x20'; Total 5; Open area with 3 Table/Chairs included
The water & electric connections are available.

\$300 booth, includes 10'x10' Total 3; Open area with 1 Table/Chairs included
Only 3 booths are available. The water & electric connections are available.

Other Booths: Total 75; Include 2ft x 6ft table & 1 chair per booth; Open area

Profit/Non-Profit: \$100 for businesses (for selling merchandise)

Profit/Non-Profit: \$100 (for businesses for distributing information/advertising)

CIO Members: \$25 for display items only

Tents: 10'x10' size; Open tent \$ 90 extra for each

Racks: \$ 25 for extra rack

1. All Booths reservations will be done on first come first serve basis;
2. Rain or shine; No rainchecks;
3. CIO reserves the right to accept or reject any request;
4. The booths will be assigned by the random draw at 10 AM on the day of the festival. All vendors are to be present before 10 AM at the site;
5. The admittance to the Great Plaza are controlled by Penn's Landing Corporation personnel. CIO is not responsible if the vendors arrive late and they are not be admitted on-site or permitted to set up their booths by the Penn's Landing employees;
6. **The area is an open plaza and CIO is not responsible if there is disruption or damage caused by inclement weather.** However open tents will be provided at an extra cost. Please bring any protective clothing/materials to safeguard your inventory, equipments, etc.;
7. All food vendors should obtain Special Event Food Service Eligibility Certificate from the Dept of Public Health, Office of Food Protection, City of Philadelphia. CIO will provide the forms on request;
8. Please note all garment /dress vendors are limited to bring only two racks. For each additional racks there will be an extra charge;
9. All food vendors will be provided with electric and water connection;
10. For non-food vendors, electric connection may be provided on request;

- 11. Vendors are required to bring their own electric extension cord/s (50' minimum);
- 12. All tables are provided with disposable table clothes;
- 13. Vendor's guidelines are enclosed and all participants are expected to comply to such guidelines.
